#### RULES

### **JUDGING**

A **100-point scoring system** will be used to determine the winner.

**35 Points:** Content — How thoroughly is the topic examined?

**30 Points:** Grammar — How well is the essay written with respect to sentence and paragraph construction?

**35 Points:** Style — Does the essay show creativity, imagination and development of the topic in a logical and compelling style?
